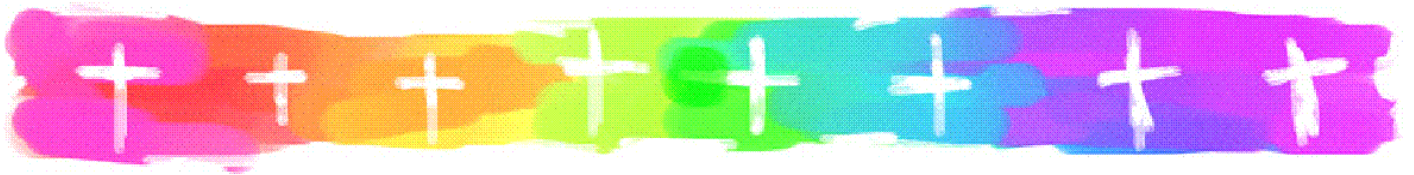
PRAYER CONCERNS, THANK YOU'S AND CONGRATULATIONS
